/// A sole-authored tamper-detection tool for AT Protocol (Bluesky) decentralised identities.

Re-verifies every did:plc operation from scratch: recomputes every CID from canonical DAG-CBOR, re-checks every ECDSA signature (secp256k1/P-256, strict low-S), re-derives DIDs from genesis bytes, and attributes each change to its signing key. Validated against official protocol test vectors and captured histories, including forks, tombstones, and legacy operations. Published on crates.io.

/// Author and maintainer since 2015, six major versions, Doctrine integration.

Implements 128-bit IPv6/CIDR arithmetic as dependency-free byte-string operations, pluggable IPv4-in-IPv6 embedding strategies (mapped, 6to4, Teredo, NAT64), and address classification aligned with the IANA special-purpose registries. One codebase, tested across ten PHP runtimes (7.1–8.5) and verified by ~6k tests, under strict SemVer and static analysis.
